INTRODUCTION



iSea is a Non-Profit Non-Governmental organisation founded in March 2016, in Greece, with the aim to protect and restore the precious heritage of the aquatic ecosystems by preserving its biodiversity and ensuring its vital functions that contribute to a clean, healthy, and productive environment. To achieve our goals, we operate in four main pillars: 1) Vulnerable species, 2) Marine protected areas, 3) Aquatic litter and 4) Human and aquatic ecosystems.

Our goal is:

- 1) the protection of aquatic ecosystems by raising awareness on current environmental problems and good practices to address them,
- 2) the promotion for the adoption of science-based measures and sound policies for the protection of the environment
- 3) the elaboration and promotion of scientific research, as the basis for sustainable development and resilience with the aim of environmental, social, and economic prosperity of the local communities.

OVERVIEW



In 2024, our organisation increased its financial position, allowing us to take significant steps toward strengthening our long-term impact on aquatic ecosystem protection. We managed to develop a five-year strategic plan, which includes clear metric indicators to measure progress toward our environmental goals. This plan also incorporates financial sustainability objectives, ensuring that we can continue our mission effectively, while prioritizing stability and capacity building for our team.

A major highlight of the year was the European Elasmobranch Association Conference, which we had the honor to host for the first time in Greece. In this report, among our financial records, we provide a comprehensive overview of the event's financial performance, highlighting key revenue sources, expenditures, and overall budget. The conference, which saw significant participation from marine biologists, shark specialists, students, and volunteers, was funded through a combination of grants, sponsorships, and attendee registrations.

Finally, investing in our equipment was also a priority this year. We managed to upgrade our boat motor, enhancing our ability to conduct field research and conservation activities more efficiently. Additionally, we expanded our infrastructure with the establishment of a new, larger field base in Menidi, Aetolia-Acarnania. This new upgraded facility allows us consistent monitoring and community engagement in the area of the Amvrakikos gulf.

Our funding network remained stable throughout the year, reflecting the enduring partnerships we have built over time. With consistent support from our long-term funders, we were able to act for the protection of the aquatic ecosystems and succeed on our financial sustainability. We look forward to further strengthening these relationships in the years ahead. 


